

## Information from College Board regarding AP Exams

Due to the closure of schools nation-wide, the College Board has made a number of changes to the upcoming AP exam administration.

- Exams will be administered directly to students through MyAP accessible via computer, tablet, or smartphone.
  - Please verify your username and password on the website where you initially registered for your AP exam(s):
    - <https://apstudents.collegeboard.org>
  - You can retrieve your username or password. If you have trouble, Mrs. Behr can give you the email address registered to your account but is unable to retrieve passwords. - Exams will be administered between May 11 and May 22.
  - The revised examination schedule features a single exam in each testing window to eliminate conflicts. *The College Board highly recommends taking the exams during the initial testing window, as any issues may then be resolved in the make-up window.* Waiting for late testing is not advised unless there are extenuating circumstances. - The exam content will include topics covered through early March. (Please note that AP teachers have been made aware of these changes and have adjusted curriculum accordingly.)
