WHAT IS THE COLLEGE ADVANTAGE PROGRAM AT ST. JOHN'S UNIVERSITY?

St. John's University is committed to providing qualified students with academic advantages as early as possible.

The **COLLEGE ADVANTAGE PROGRAM** at St. John's provides qualifying high school juniors and seniors with the opportunity to **ENROLL CONCURRENTLY IN HIGH SCHOOL AND CREDIT BEARING ST. JOHN'S COURSES** at a cost of \$325 per course, a deep discount from regular undergraduate tuition rates.

CLASSES ARE TAUGHT AT STUDENT'S HIGH SCHOOL by approved teachers in areas of study that include English, mathematics, language, fine arts, science, social sciences, and humanities.

College Advantage students who enroll at St. John's University the semester after high school graduation may receive a **\$2,000 TUITION GRANT** per year for up to four years of continuous, full-time undergraduate study at St. John's.

HOW TO APPLY

Please note the timeline below regarding the application and registration process for College Advantage. **IT TAKES GENERALLY ONE TO TWO WEEKS TO COMPLETE THE STEPS NOTED HERE:**

- Student submits application between January 9 and February 6, 2019
- St. John's will process the application (this will take approximately one week)
- St. John's will issue both electronic and paper bills (both will be sent to the contact information the student provides on the online application)
- Paper bills will include courses in which student is registered
- Both the electronic and paper bills will contain instructions regarding how to submit payment
- Student submits payment no later than February 13, 2019
- Upon receipt of payment, enrollment will be complete
